## General Event Rules

**Participation is limited to 100 Union infantry, 100 Confederate infantry, 3 Union cannons with crews, 3 Confederate cannons with crews, BOUNTY PAID PER CANNON!!!!!!! 141<sup>st</sup> PVI, Company A reserves the right to limit the number of civilian reenactors and Living Historians.**

**No rank above Captain is permitted without prior authorization**

NO LIVE AMMUNITION, FIREWORKS OR MODERN FIREARMS will be allowed on the grounds. Violators will be expelled from the event.

NO PETS OR LIVESTOCK will be allowed on the grounds.

No modern camping will be provided.

With the exception of authorized photographers, cinematographers, press, etc., all other personnel must film from the spectator viewing area only. Special credentials will be issued by 141st PVI, Company A and must be carried at all times. No recordings, photos or videos may be manufactured and sold on or off site at any time without prior approval and written consent from 141st PVI, Company A. 141st PVI, Company A retains all intellectual property rights to any and all images derived from past, present and future events. Violators will be subject to legal proceedings.

141st PVI, Company A, or agents thereof, reserve the right to immediately expel any persons in violation of any rules listed within this document as well as any persons acting in an unsafe, disrespectful, destructive or disrupting way in any fashion.

All clothing must accurately represent the fashion and style of the historical period portrayed.

Modern style glasses and frames are not permitted. Sunglasses were not worn in the mid 19th century.

Footwear is restricted to brogans and approved period boots and shoes.

No specialty impressions without the approval of the event organizers.

## General Event Rules

(con't)

Women portraying soldiers in the ranks should make every reasonable effort to hide their gender.

Ice angels are allowed. However, they must be in period clothing.

All anachronisms (cots, coolers, etc.) must be hidden from view at all times.

Please make an effort to confine tobacco use to period correct methods.

Fire pits are allowed. These must be filled in at the close of Sunday's schedule.

All campfires should have a minimum of 1 bucket of water close at hand.

Consumption of alcoholic beverages and /or use of illegal drugs is prohibited.

Adequate firewood will be supplied by 141st PVI, Company A.

Potable water will be supplied by 141st PVI, Company A

All vehicles must be out of camp by Saturday morning at 8:00 AM

No vehicles will be allowed into camp until after the close of the battle on Sunday.

Civilians remaining in camp during the reenactment **MUST** be in period clothing.

After the battle on Sunday, all trash should be bagged and placed at the head of your street.
